ITEM 7 PRESCRIBING REPORT

The committee were assured that prescribing had achieved a significant projected under spend of £2 million and generic prescribing rates are the third best CCG in the Yorkshire and Humber SHA area.

The committee were assured that the action plans were appropriate and performing against targets and requested that additional items be added to reflect emerging risks.

ITEM 8 BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE

Members of the committee were assured of the position relating to performance targets and on-going actions in relation to performance.

ITEM 9 BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE FRAMEWORK

Assurance was provided that the new Business Intelligence Framework met the Committees requirements in terms of performance, finance and patient experience.
