### **Proposed Changes to Practice Boundary - Wolseley Medical Centre (B81047)**

Existing patients who currently live outside the new boundary will continue to be serviced until they move residence when they will be advised that they will need to find an alternative GP Practice</p>

The Primary Care Commissioning Committee is asked to note the report and make a decision based on the information in the report.

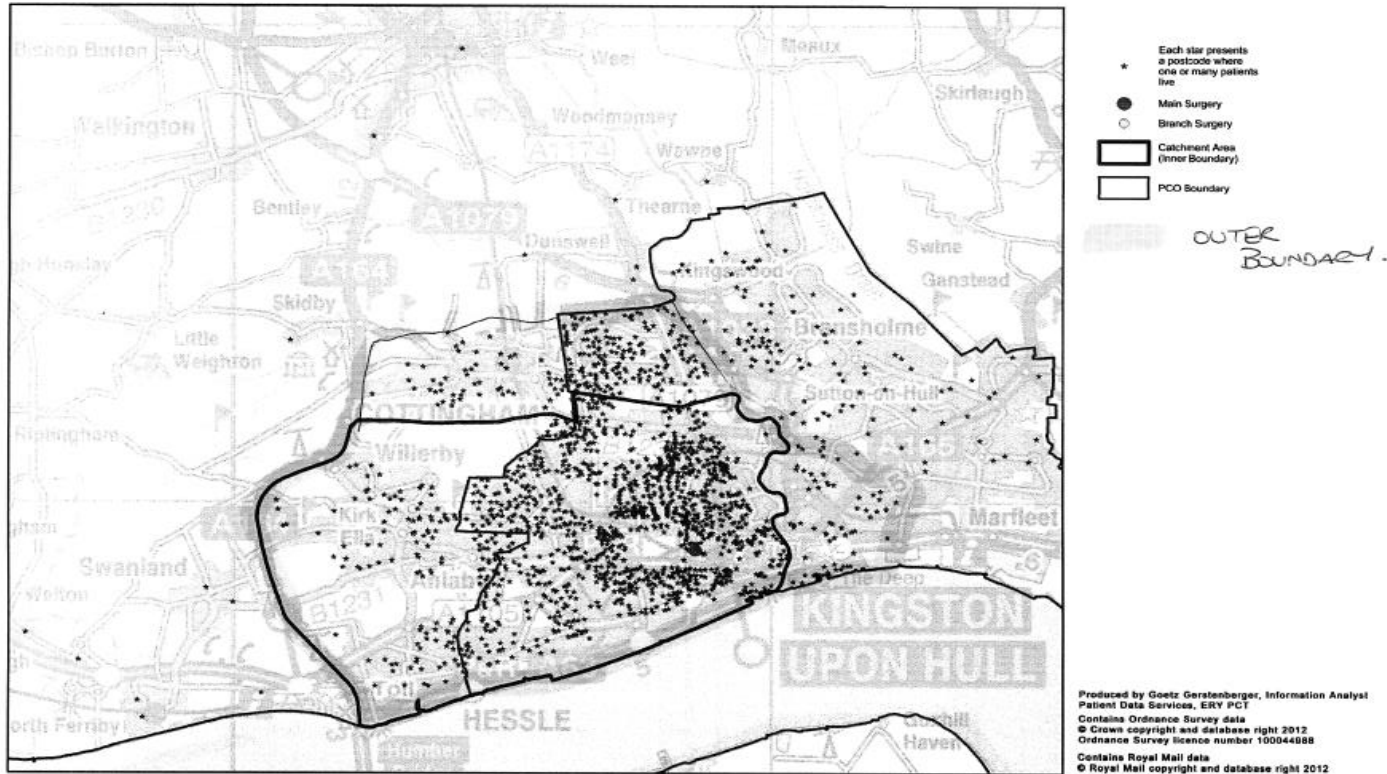
