CHAIR'S UPDATE REPORT
PART 1**

INTRODUCTION

This is the Chair's report to the Clinical Commissioning Group Board following the February 2019 Primary Care Commissioning Committee.

GOVERNANCE

There were no items of Governance considered by the Committee.

STRATEGY

The Committee considered an application to expand the practice boundary of Field View Surgery, further information was requested before making a decision. The Committee considered and approved a 3 month extension to the list closure of Wolseley Medical Centre. The Committee considered and approved a consolidation of practice boundaries for the Calvert & Newington Practice (Haxby Group).

The Committee noted NHS England's plans to equalise GMS and PMS payments per patient from April 2020 and also noted that Modality Hull planned further engagement work would be undertaken in relation to proposals to reconfigure services delivered from New Hall Surgery, Newland Group and Faith House surgeries.


The Committee received information regarding changes to the GP contract and specifically the development of Primary Care Networks and the new Network DES.

SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT & IMPLEMENTATION

The Committee approved the extension of the existing Extended Primary Care Medical Services contracts and Minor Surgery services and the principle of including these services within the Network DES in future.

The Committee approved a proposal for the CCG to take full delegated responsibility for primary care PALS and complaints.

The Committee approved the carry forward of the 2018/19 Local Quality Premium Schemes to the end of June 2019 in order to align with the timetable for the development of Primary Care Networks.
