# **PRIMARY CARE NETWORKS APPROVAL**

## **1 INTRODUCTION**

The purpose of this paper is to update the Committee on progress in approving Primary Care Networks following the Extraordinary Primary Care Commissioning Committee held on 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

## **2 PRIMARY CARE NETWORK APPROVAL PROCESS**

The Extraordinary Primary Care Commissioning Committee held on 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019 was informed that the CCG had received 5 Primary Care Network registration submissions by the 15<sup>th</sup> May deadline. It was also noted that 2 practices within Hull at that stage had received offers to join a Primary Care Network and would be making a decision by 28<sup>th</sup> May. Consequently the Committee resolved to delegate approval of Primary Care Networks in Hull to the Vice Chair Primary Care Commissioning Committee, Chief Finance Officer (Director Lead for Primary Care) and CCG Chair.

Following confirmation on 28<sup>th</sup> May by the Primary Care Networks that all practices were included within a Primary Care Network the Vice Chair Primary Care Commissioning Committee, Chief Finance Officer (Director Lead for Primary Care) and CCG Chair met on 29<sup>th</sup> May to review the submissions and to confirm that there was 100% geographical coverage of the CCG.

A meeting of the Humber Coast and Vale Primary Care Programme Board on 30<sup>th</sup> May 2019 subsequently considered the Primary Care Networks across all 6 CCGs and approved all proposed Primary Care Networks.

The confirmed NHS Hull CCG Primary Care Networks as at 1<sup>st</sup> June are as set out in the table overleaf.
