**INTRODUCTION**

**GOVERNANCE**


There were no items of Governance discussed.

**STRATEGY**

The Committee noted the staged merger of Goodheart Surgery and Dr Gopal with Dr Gopal's contract being known as Goodheart Surgery (Dr G) until a clinical system merger later in the year. The Committee approved a list closure extension of 6 months for Dr Cook. The Committee received an update regarding video consultation which was available in all practices and online consultation. It was agreed that implementation dates would be agreed with the 5 practices yet to have online consultation in place.

**SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT & IMPLEMENTATION**

The Committee received a report in relation to provision of primary medical care services in the context of the COVID 19 pandemic. The report detailed the incident management process and structure; summarised the changes that had taken place, in line with national guidance, with regard to service provision; the provision of hot and cold sites and the situation reporting process established. The Committee also received the risk report which updated risks within the context of COVID-19.
