aPMS Contracts - Christmas 2020 Bank Holiday Opening

1 Background

Hull has 5 aPMS contracts; 3 of these are open 8am-8pm Monday to Friday and 9am-1pm on Saturday, 1 is open 8am-8pm Monday to Sunday and the other was procured with GMS opening hours (8am-6.30pm Monday to Friday).

2 aPMS Contracts

Core Hours are "unless expressed more extensively, the period beginning at 8am and ending at 8pm on any day from Monday to Friday and 9am to 1pm on a Saturday as agreed with the commissioner except Good Friday, Christmas Day or Bank Holidays and Sunday".

Out of Hours are expressed as "(a) the period beginning at 8pm on any day from Monday to Friday and ending at 8am on the following day; (b) the period between 1pm Saturday and 8am Monday (c) Good Friday, Christmas Day and Bank Holidays".

3 GMS / PMS Contracts

Core Hours are "unless expressed more extensively, the period beginning at 8am and ending at 6.30pm on any day from Monday to Friday except Good Friday, Christmas Day or Bank Holidays".

Out of Hours are expressed as "(a) the period beginning at 6.30pm on any day from Monday to Thursday and ending at 8am on the following day; (b) the period between 6.30pm on Friday and 8am on the following Monday; and (c) Good Friday, Christmas Day and Bank Holidays".

4 Christmas Bank Holidays 2020

Christmas Day this year falls on Friday 25th December with Boxing Day falling on Saturday 26th December. As Boxing Day falls on a Saturday, the Bank Holiday substitute day is Monday 28th December.

As a result, one of our aPMS practices has queried opening on Saturday 26th December and has asked whether they can either (a) not open as it should be a Bank Holiday or (b) reprovide the 4hrs hours on another day as it is a Saturday and contractually they should be open.

It is anticipated that activity will be low due to all intents and purposes it being Boxing Day and patients viewing it as so. Activity provided by the practice for previous years support this with more activity preceding and following the Bank Holidays.

The Extended Access Service will be providing appointments on Saturday 26th December which will be accessible by all patients including those with aPMS contracts.
